- WEAR RED!! In the church year, the Day of Pentecost is the culmination of the 50 days of the Easter celebration. After showing himself to the disciples and after having ascended, Jesus' followers received the promised gift of the Holy Spirit. Given the nature of the occasion as the closing of the most joyous season of the church, the Day of Pentecost deserves to be celebrated more enthusiastically than often is the case. The church's witness to the presence and power of Christ's Spirit should never be obscured.
- As a way to celebrate this festive day, everyone is invited to WEAR RED to worship on Sunday, May 23rd. Red is often worn to worship on the Day of Pentecost recalling the red flames of the Holy Spirit. As we see the parking lot full of red, we are reminded visually of the Spirit being ever-present among us.

From the Pastors.....

God of tempest, God of whirlwind, as on Pentecost descend! Drive us out from sheltered comfort; past these walls your people send. Sweep us into costly service, there with Christ to bear the cross, there with Christ to bear the cross.

-God of Tempest, God of Whirlwind, ELW 400

God of Tempest, God of Whirlwind is one of our favorite hymns to sing on Pentecost. It has a feel and movement within it that makes you want to belt it out with gusto. The tricky thing about the song, as is the case with so many songs that are fun to sing, is that while you are boldly singing it, it is easy to not really pay attention to the lyrics—which is always a mistake (whether we are singing a hit pop song in the car by ourselves or a hymn in church).

For this particular song, the lyrics are all good, faithful, theologically sound statements. It is just, do we *really* mean them when we sing them?

- Do we *really* want the Spirit to appear as on Pentecost?
- Do we *really* want to be driven out of our comforts (past the walls around us)?
- Do we *really* want to be swept up in service (service that is specifically *costly*)?
- Do we *really* want to be present with Christ to bear the cross?

These are all challenging, sacrificial kinds of desires. So, perhaps phrasing our questions around *wanting* to experience those items is not the right angle of approach. Maybe, a better way to frame our point is to emphasize how these lyrics, while not necessarily fun or enjoyable in and of themselves, do go along with our commitment to follow Christ. Living the life of a disciple *is* challenging and sacrificial. And yet, it is through such things where we can clearly witness and experience God's power at work.

In addition, what these questions of ours fail to emphasize are the ways in which all these lyrics *have already* been manifesting themselves over the past year!

- God's spirit *has been* blowing around this world in powerful ways—how else can we explain how we have made it to this point together!
- We, as a community, *have* literally been driven out of the comforts of our walls!
- We *have* been swept up into costly service—out of love of our neighbors and care of ourselves, we have altered our lives in countless ways!
- We *have* carried crosses and experienced various deaths—with Christ's presence and help we have also begun to experience the reality of resurrection.

God of Tempest, God of Whirlwind is a great hymn. As it will soon reappear on Pentecost, which happens to be the date of CIC's Annual Meeting, be sure to take note of the lyrics when it is sung. Reflect on how you and all of us have been living the song out over the past year...and begin to ponder how the lyrics might express themselves in the upcoming weeks and months.

This life of faith that we have committed ourselves to *is* challenging and sacrificial. As such, we likely do not always feel like living it with as much gusto as we probably should, but as difficult as it is at times, those are the kinds of situations, places, and people where God's love is most powerfully seen and felt. Whatever this upcoming year may bring, whether we can literally sing or not, let us continue to be bold in following our crucified and risen Savior.

Sunday Worship & Weekday Worship Opportunities:

May 2, 9, 16 & 30 there will be a 9 a.m. Drive-in Worship and 10:30 am Sanctuary Worship. Livestreaming of Sunday worship continues via Facebook and YouTube @ 10:30a.m. May 23 will be one service at 10 a.m. followed by the annual meeting.

• Service of Holy Communion—Join us on Wednesdays, May 12th and 19th for a brief service of Holy Communion in the sanctuary at 12 p.m. The service will contain the reading of scripture, prayers, instrumental music, and the communion liturgy. The service is approximately 15 minutes. Communion distribution is in prepackaged containers. You are seated a minimum of 6 feet from anyone not in your family unit and you must wear a mask while inside the building. Please refer to our worship gathering information on the church website. Look to weekly Take Twos for additional and up-to-date gathering information as the dates approach.


