Community In Christ is an ELCA Lutheran Church located two miles west of I-77 at Exit 25. Our office hours are 9:30 am-5:00 pm Monday through Friday. During the school year (September through May) we have worship at 9:00 am & 11:00 am on Sundays. Nursery is available during Sunday Worship. We have a Wednesday evening worship at 7 pm. Communion is served at all services. Adult and Children's Sunday School is at 10 am. During the summer months (Memorial weekend through the 2nd Sunday of September) we have one service at 10 am with nursery available. An open invitation is extended to everyone to share our joy of Christian fellowship in worship and life.



From the Pastors.....

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever—Hebrews 13:8

As we enter into the program year at Community in Christ, we're excited about many things. The rhythm of activities at the church. The new opportunities for ministry. The growing and tending of relationships. The worship life. The music. The congregational meals. The time together. The warm weather that stays through September (okay, that's not about you, that's still our thawing Upper Midwesternness talking!). It's exciting to think of all we are and will be experiencing together.

Within this reflection, we want to share with you in more detail two happenings that are adding to our excitement. One of the happenings focuses on the preschool. The room outside of the Fellowship Hall has recently been transitioned to Sharon's office and preschool storage area. There is great value in having the Preschool Director located on the preschool hallway. Most importantly, this transition allows for better security for the 70 little ones our program is stewards of throughout the week. The change also gives improved efficiency for Sharon, the teachers, and all of CIC's office staff. Over time, additional steps will be taken to make the preschool wing more secure throughout the day. This was the first step that we and the Church Council discerned to take. *In conjunction with this first step, we ask that everyone entering the church building during the preschool day to please use the door located by the church office.*

We and others will be visioning what possibilities this transition of rooms creates. The two spaces Sharon previously occupied are in a holding pattern while we look at functionality and needs of all areas of the church. For those groups who previously met in the aforementioned room, we are committed to making sure they find a new location that meets the needs of their group. And, with a little creativity, we're confident that will happen.

We're also excited that, when we return to two worship services on Sunday, September 15th, our morning will begin with contemporary worship at 9 a.m. followed by 10 a.m. Sunday School and 11 a.m. traditional worship. The 9 a.m. service will be a 50-minute service allowing everyone time to transition to Sunday School. Sunday School will run until 10:45 a.m. allowing transition time to the next worship service.

Here are a few things this Sunday morning timeframe allows us all:

- to continue hearing from some of our youngest Jesus followers during worship and to experience the means of grace with them at our sides.
- to have the opportunity for fellowship between services (the coffee cart will be open!). The hour between services can serve as a bridge which enables attendees from both services to see one another.
- to give Sandy the opportunity to work with the Sunday School students and help them learn songs that can then be shared during worship.
- to make sure Sunday School teachers have the chance to worship at the service of their choice.

If you didn't catch it already, we're EXCITED for much of what is to come throughout this upcoming stretch of time here at CIC. For you, perhaps excitement isn't the same descriptor you would use to identify how you're feeling. And that's okay! Transitions such as the one we're currently in can produce an array of emotions. May we remember that as things in our lives, families, work, church, and communities change, as they inevitably do, the sustaining love and grace of Christ remains the same as it was yesterday and today and tomorrow ... and that is something we can not only be excited about but be eternally grateful for.



Preschool News


The teachers are ready and excited to start a new year! The halls are decorated and soon the sound of laughter and little feet will be echoing in the hallways.


