Thank you all for your continued giving through this year of transition. The Finance Committee and Council expected a decline in giving and have been monitoring our spending very closely. We are very pleased that the level of giving has been higher than we anticipated. In addition, Community In Christ has been able to support outside ministries due to your generosity. The latest recipient was Habitat for Humanity. You, the congregation, donated \$2,000.00 during the month of May. The Outreach committee voted to add an additional \$1,000.00 from their prior year OUT funds. In addition, the total amount collected and paid to Mission Investment to reduce our mortgage was \$199,499.21!!! Please keep those pledge payments coming. Every time you make a payment, we reduce our principal mortgage debt.


