



According to the USDA's latest *Household Food Insecurity in the United States* report, more than 35 million people in the United States struggled with hunger in 2019. Due to the effects of the coronavirus pandemic, more than 50 million people may experience food insecurity, including a potential of 17 million children. From the Pastors.....

The rain fell on the earth forty days and forty nights.

Genesis 7:12

Elijah went in the strength of that food forty days and forty nights to Horeb the mount of God. 1 Kings 19:8

Jesus fasted forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was famished.

Matthew 4:2

24 hours, 9 innings, 7 days, 3 periods, 60 seconds, 4 quarters, 60 minutes, 365 days...our world has a variety of different ways to understand and calculate time. From the perspective of a game, we might think in terms of quarters or periods. From the perspective of a day, we might think in terms of minutes or hours.

For Christians, 40 days and 40 nights has traditionally been understood as an important measure of time. One can find that rich biblical image throughout scripture helping differentiate from what we might consider to be "ordinary" time. Lent takes us somewhere between the beginning and the end of the Gospel story--it is a time in our faith for preparation, for contemplation, for anticipation, for action, and for growth.

Time has been anything but ordinary for the last year. We have learned to measure the days and weeks by positivity rates, case counts, hospital capacities, unemployment numbers, vaccine distributions, indoor capacity limits, and a slew of other gauges that tell us if we are trending in positive or negative ways. One of the most difficult elements of time during the last year is that, even now with the hope of the vaccine having become realized, we don't know when this will all end. We can't set our clocks to anything or circle a date on a calendar.

As we wait with eager anticipation for this time of pandemic to conclude, we have the season of Lent on the horizon. Lent is a set aside time of the year that includes a clear beginning with Ash Wednesday and a definitive conclusion with the celebration of Easter. What we do with this season, how we mark this time, will be up to us. Following this reflection, you will find some of the worship opportunities we will be providing during these 40 days and 40 nights. In addition to those, be sure to take note of some other Lenten happenings that are shared in the newsletter.

Whatever we do to fill these 40 days and nights, the purpose of Lent will always be to deepen our relationship with God and to ready ourselves for the joy of Easter morning. New life is coming! Sometimes, we can create a countdown towards it. Other times, it catches us by surprise. The new life we have in Christ is not bound by any unit of time we might construct, just like it was not bound by the cross or tomb. What we know is that new life *will come* and, indeed, it is already here.

Sunday Worship & Weekday Worship Opportunities:

Outdoor, In-person worship Sundays at 10 a.m. Livestreaming of Sunday worship continues via Facebook and YouTube @ 10 a.m.

- Service of Holy Communion—Join us on Wednesdays, February 3rd, 10th and 24th for a brief service of Holy Communion in the sanctuary at 12 p.m. The service will contain the reading of scripture, prayers, instrumental music, and the communion liturgy. The service will be approximately 15 minutes. Communion will be distributed in prepackaged containers. Please enter the sanctuary through the doors under the Portico and exit through the doors leading to the breezeway. You will be seated a minimum of 6 feet from anyone not in your family unit and you must wear a mask while inside the building. Please refer to the signage on the church door before entering the building. Space is limited to 10 people. Look to weekly Take Twos for additional and up-to-date gathering information as the dates approach.

- 1. Online/Direct Withdrawal
 - A. Go to www.communityinchrist.org & click on the "donate now" button in the upper righthand corner.
 - B. Select "Create Profile"
 - C. Provide your email address
 - D. Create your profile and provide the various pieces of information. Once your profile is created, you can select what types of giving you would like sign-up for.
 - *When considering this option, please note that church incurs an additional service charge for credit card fees.
- **2. Mail In:** We have a locked mailbox at CIC that is checked frequently. CIC's address is 7621 Norman Island Drive, Cornelius, NC 28031
- **3. Offering Plate:** The ushers provide a contact-free opportunity for you to place your offering in the offering plate during drive-in worship.

<u>Shrove Tuesday</u>, <u>February 16th</u>: You will have the opportunity to pick up some fun and tasty supplies for your Shrove Tuesday At Home meal on February 7th and February 14th after our outdoor service. You may also schedule a time to pick up at the church office during the week. If you would like the supplies brought to your home, please notify the office

Ash Wednesday, February 17th: We will have outdoor worship services on February 17th at 2:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. These services will include the imposition of ashes as well as the celebration of Holy Communion. The 7p.m. service will be livestreamed. Participants will receive their own, pre-packaged ashes. If unable to attend in-person, ashes may be picked up in advance at services on the 7th and 14th (or by setting up a time with the office during the week), so that they can be imposed as you worship via the livestream.

<u>Midweek Lenten Services</u>: On Wednesdays beginning February 24th through March 24th, a midweek service including music from Holden Evening Prayer will be posted on Facebook and YouTube at 5:00 p.m. The reflection each week will focus on the theme of community.

<u>Tuesday Morning CIC Bible Study</u>: During the season of Lent, the Bible Study will focus on Dr. Mark Allen Powell's series, *How Lutherans Interpret the Bible*. The series will begin on February 16th at 10:30 a.m. If you have not participated in the study previously, please contact the church office for the Zoom information. Also, the Bible Study is always recorded so, if you are unable to participate at the 10:30 a.m. time, the recording can be e-mailed to you.


